POLICIES

• Service Animals and Pets

Service animals are always allowed on Skyline. A service animal is defined as any guide dog, signal dog, or other animal that has been individually trained to work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability. Pets are allowed only if they are kept in a cage or carrier. The carrier must be small enough to be placed under the seat or on the passenger's lap without inconveniencing other riders.


• Elderly and Disabled Priority Seating

Riding Skyline is easy with the HOLO card!

A HOLO card is required for all riders over the age of 5 years old. Children 5 years and under are FREE when accompanied by a fare-paying rider.

RIDE IN 4 EASY STEPS

- 1 PURCHASE AND LOAD YOUR HOLO CARD AT HOLOCARD.NET, A HOLO RETAILER, OR AT HOLO VENDING MACHINES AT TRAIN STATIONS.

Only adult passes can be purchased at stations.



- 2 TAP YOUR HOLO CARD ON YOUR RIGHT. Use the card reader at the fare gate. Tap below the digital screen.



- 3 STAY CLEAR OF THE FARE GATE. Enter only after hearing the chime. Gates will close immediately after you pass through.



- 4 USE THE WIDE FARE GATES IF YOU NEED MORE TIME.

The wide gates are best for kūpuna, disabled, and riders with bicycles and luggage. When entering with keiki, always keep them close and enter with them in front of you. The wide gates are marked by symbols on the glass.



Free transfers between Skyline and TheBus with your HOLO card. Just tap the card reader as you transfer.

TheBus CONNECTIONS

- TheBus routes service all stations except Honouliuli Ho'opili Station and Hālauani LCC Station.
 - At Āhua Lagoon Drive Station, new and frequent TheBus lines connect Skyline riders to and from major destinations in Honolulu.
 - A Line:** Rapid service to and from Downtown, Ala Moana and UH Mānoa.
 - U Line:** Express service directly to and from UH Mānoa via the H-1 Freeway.
 - W Line:** Rapid service to and from Waikīkī via Kalihi and Kaka'ako on Nimitz Highway.
 - TheBus connects Skyline riders to and from Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam at the Makalapa Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam Station. *Valid ID is required for entry into secured military space.*
 - Route PH8:** Frequent service to and from Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard
 - Route 331:** Service to and from Hickam, PACAF Command, and AMC Terminal.
